Alan Piercy was born and spent his early childhood years in the country (farm land) in central Illinois. He always had a bit of country in his veins even after moving to the concrete jungle of Southern CA. He graduated from one of the largest Agricultural Universities in the US, California Polytechnic State University in San Luis Obispo with his degree in Business Administration (concentration in Accounting). He utilized that degree by designing integrated accounting systems for corporations within various industries (Manufacturing, Apparel, Construction, Environmental and Retail organizations). In all, he spent 18 years selling, architecting and implementing various types of integrated automated systems. He now utilizes this design and implementation experience to Reduce, Reuse and Recycle our organic waste stream resources into rich soil amendments.

In 2003, Alan bought 50 percent interest into the largest and oldest established operating worm farm in Southern California, last known as VermiPRO. Then in 2007, he founded ENRECOS, Inc. an environmental corporation that provides organic recycling solutions and their byproducts. Such as worms, worm castings, worm tea, vermicompost and compost. He currently designs, consults and manufactures residential and commercial worm bins. Along with conducting; lectures, presentations and workshops for different municipalities.
